

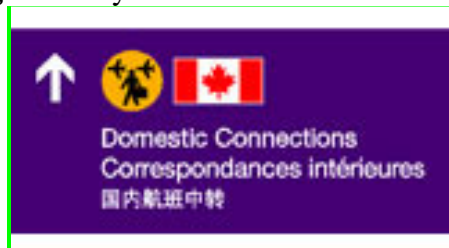
Connecting to your Domestic Flight to Winnipeg after arrival in Vancouver

1. Proceed to Domestic Connections

- Claim your Baggage from your international flight



- Give your **declaration card** → to the Canada Border Services officer and **exit to the right**
- **Follow the sign** that says Domestic Connections.



2. Drop-Off Checked Baggage

- **Drop-off** your checked baggage at the **Air Canada bag belt**. Please ensure you have a **boarding pass and baggage claim tags** for your **connecting flight** – if you do not, you will need to check-in on Connections Level 4.

3. Proceed to Domestic Terminal

- Take the **elevator** to Connections **Level 4**.
- If you have already **checked in your bags** and have a **boarding pass**, proceed towards the gates.
- If you do not have a boarding pass or need to check-in oversize baggage, please recheck-in at the Air Canada counters.

4. Security Checkpoint

- For information on the pre-board screening process including packing tips and a list of permitted and non-permitted items, see the [Security](#) section.

5. Proceed to Departures Level 3

- Take the elevator, escalator or stairs **down to the Departures Level 3**.

6. Find Your Gate

- Follow the signs to your designated boarding gate. Confirm your assigned gate and time



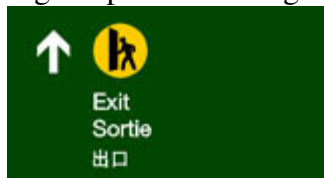

If you get lost or can't find the domestic terminal:

1. Public Greeting Area

- Follow the exit sign to proceed through automatic glass doors to the public greeting area.



2. Proceed to Domestic Departures

- Take the escalator or elevator up to International Terminal, Departures Level 3.
- Follow the signs to Domestic Terminal Departures.



3. Check-in

- If you don't already have your boarding pass, proceed to your airline's designated check-in counters or kiosks to check-in.
- Learn about your [options](#) for checking-in online, at YVR or at other locations.

4. Baggage Check-in

- If you have your boarding pass or have just checked-in, report to your airline's check-in area and follow their procedures for checking and dropping off your baggage.

5. Security Checkpoint

- Follow the signs to your designated boarding gate – A, B or C - to find the closest security checkpoint.

6. Find Your Gate

- Follow the signs to your designated boarding gate. Confirm your assigned gate and time for boarding on the flight information display screens.
