- GPA Admission Requirements for Advanced Entry:
  - Students are expected to complete a minimum 24 credit hours by the end of April, with 30 unique credit hours completed by the end of August of the application year. Students who need to complete required course and the 24 credit hours requirement in the Summer term for the Fall intake, will only be considered for admission on a space available basis after all other eligible students have been considered.
    - These applicants must notify the admissions office by email <u>admissions.kinandrec@umanitoba.ca</u> of their intention to complete admissions requirements in the summer term.
  - Bachelor of Recreation Management and Community Development (BRMCD): Adjusted Grade Point Average (AGPA) of 2.0. (See Application Information Bulletin Section 2)
